WHITES

House white, Dry or Medium - Vin de Pays Côtes de Gascogne

Fresh, fruity & excellent value

Casa Defra - Pinot Grigio Venezia

Dry and clean, with an aftertaste of sagebrush flowers that lingers persistently

Pouilly Fumé “La Rambarde” 2006, Domaine Landrat-Guyollet

Gun-flinty, fruity with a peach and lemon zest on the nose and the palate. Good acidity for this elegant wine.

Sarantos Chardonnay, Kingston Estate, Riverland, South Australia

Clean and naturally balanced with just the fresh, pure taste of premium Chardonnay

Fox Grove Semillon/Chardonnay

Rich and round wine with notes of butter, vanilla and pineapple

3 Stones – Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough

A classic Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc. Mouth-filling, rich in the palate, with a bright and juicy finish

ROSE

Manon - Côtes de Provence Rosé – CellierVal de Durance

Brilliant pink colour. Elegant nose with attractive floral and stone fruits aromas.

Casa Defra Pinot Grigio Blush - Rosé

Delightfully elegant Rosé

Saumur Sparkling Rosé Château de Montguéret

Starts in strength & continues in character, elegant finish

Camille Savès, Carte Blanche Brut, 1^{er} Cru

The Savès Family has grown fine grapes since 1894 and has an exceptional range of Champagne.

Carte Blanche is 75% Pinot Noir and 25% Chardonnay with a fine and elegant mousse.

Camille Savès, Grand Cru Rosé

The distinctive and delicate aroma of this Grand Cru Champagne comes from the right balance between using mainly White Chardonnay grapes and the addition of Pinot Noir grapes.

Ideal for Aperitif or with fruity dessert.

REDS

House red – Vin de Pays de Vaucluse

Fruity & robust with a soft round finish.

Fox Grove, Shiraz/Cabernet

Round and easy to drink, with silky tannins and a persistent aroma

Lar de Barros Crianza – Tempranillo - Bodegas Inviosa

Ample & aromatic in the mouth with a certain well-balanced touch of tannin

Lar de Lares '02 Reserva, Bodegas Inviosa

100% Tempranillo. Powerful, ample & full-bodied wine. The fruit is beautifully integrated and the finish soft and long.

Casa Defra Cabernet Sauvignon Colli Berici

Full, body, harmonious and velvety

Château Les Amoureuses “La Barbare”

70% Syrah & 30% Mourvèdre, Grenache and old vines. Aged in oak barrel for 9 to 12 months.

Great complexity with a spicy note, blackberry aroma and a final edge of chocolate.

Sarantos Merlot, Kingston Estate, Riverland, South Australia

A rich generous wine with plenty of raspberry and cherry characters. The palate is soft and smooth
